

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"Racial and ethnic minorities tend to receive a lower quality of healthcare than non-minorities, even when access-related factors, such as patients' insurance status and income, are controlled. The sources of these disparities are complex, are rooted in historic and contemporary inequities, and involve many participants at several levels, including health systems, their administrative and bureaucratic processes, utilization managers, healthcare professionals, and patients"

## Origins of Racist Ideas in the Colonies

- 17th century: Richard Mather, John Cotton, Cotton Mather- puritan ministers in New England inherited their European forefathers ideas that African slavery was normal, natural and holy.
- Chattel slavery 1619 1865: African Americans treated as personal property and bought and sold as commodities. Doctor/slave owner dyad
- Climate theory and Curse theory were used as an explanation of black skin and the justification for slavery
- **Colonization**: *Jefferson, Lincoln*. The American Colonization Society was formed in 1817 to send African Americans to Africa or South America as an alternative to emancipation in the United States
- The abolitionist physician, *Benjamin Rush*, and anti-slavery advocate, *Samuel Sandhope Smith*, also had some racist ideas.

## Scientific Racism


Scientific racism: sometimes referred to as race biology, is a pseudoscientific belief that empirical evidence exists to support or justify racism (racial discrimination), racial inferiority, or racial superiority.

# Ethnology: The study of the characteristics, differences and relationships between various peoples

- Polygenism- is a theory of human origins which states that the *human* <u>races</u> are of different origins (polygenesis).
- Monogenism- a single origin of humanity (monogenesis).
- Eugenics controlled breeding to improve a human population. Sir Francis Galton

V. "The Ethiopian Race is characterised by a black complexion, and black, woolly hair; the eyes are large and prominent, the noise broad and flat, lips thick, and the mouth wide; the head long and narrow, the forehead low, the cheek bones prominent, the jaws projecting, and the chin small. In disposition, the negro is joyous, flexible, and indolent; while the many nations which compose this race present a singular diversity of intellectual character, of which the far extreme is the lowest grade of humanity."

This race is divided into—17th, The Negro; 18th, The Caffrarian; 19th, The Hottentot; 20th, The Oceanic Negro; 21st, The Australian; and 22d, The Alforian families. The latter family is most numerous in New Guinea, the Moluccas, and Magindano.






I. "The Carcasian Race is characterised by a naturally fair skin, susceptible of every tint; hair fine, long, and curling, and of various colours. The skull is large and oval, and its anterior portion full and elevated. The face is small in proportion to the head, of an oval form, with well-proportioned features. The nasal bones are arched, the chin full, and the teeth vertical. The race is distinguished for the facility with which it attains the highest intellectual endowments."

### 1840 US Census


- The 1840 Census intentionally erred to show more lunacy/insanity among free blacks in the north than in enslaved blacks in the south in order to justify slavery.
- Psychiatrist and statistician, *Edward Jarvis*, and black physician, *James McCune Smith*, published reviews demonstrating the errors in the 1840 Census.
- US Secretary of State, *John C. Calhoun*, certified the census correct and promoted the errors.








Agassiz Zealy slave portraits




Agassez expressed revulsion on first encountering African Americans.

### Josiah Clark Nott

American Surgeon and anthropologist 1804-1873

Josiah Clarke Nott- "the negro achieves his greatest perfection, physical and moral, and also greatest longevity, in a state of slavery".

Noted for his studies on Yellow fever, Nott was a founder of the <u>Medical College</u> of Alabama, established in Mobile in 1858. He served there as a Professor of Surgery. During the <u>American Civil War</u>, he served as a <u>Confederate</u> surgeon and <u>staff officer</u>.






Illustration from *Types of Mankind* (1854),

white man voluntarily imposes on himself. If force be used to make them do more, they invariably do less and less, until they fall into a state of impassivity, in which they are more plague than profit—worthless as laborers, insensible and indifferent to punishment, or even to life; or, in other words, they fall into the disease which I have named Dysesthæsia Ethiopica, characterized by hebetude of mind and insensibility of body, caused by over-working and bad treatment. Some knowledge of the ethnology of the prognathous race is absolutely necessary for the prevention and cure of this malady in all its various forms and stages. Dirt eating, or Cachexia Africana, is another disease, like Dysesthæsia Ethiopica, growing out of ethnical elements peculiar to the prognathous race. The ethnical elements assimilating the negro to the mule, although giving rise to the last named disease, are of vast importance to the prognathous race, because they guaranty to that race an ample protection against the abuses of arbitrary power. A white man, like a blooded horse, can be worked to death. Not so the negro, whose ethnical elements, like the mule, restrict the limits of arbitrary power

## 20<sup>th</sup> Century Scientific Racism

- Birth control activist and nurse, Margaret Sanger, a collaborator with W.E.B. DuBois, was a proponent of eugenics.
- Mississippi appendectomy- Fannie Lou Hamer
- Psychologist, Arthur Jensen (1969), and physicist, William Shockley (1960s) promoted the development of I.Q. tests (1916) to verify that the upper-class whites were proven to be more intelligent
- The Bell Curve (1994) by Richard Herrnstein and Charles Murray- racial difference in intelligence
- Human genetic variation: 99.9% the same. Is racial difference explained in the .1%?

### Research and Treatment Abuses

Non-therapeutic and harmful research and harmful experimental treatment

• "The future of the negro lies more in the research laboratory than in schools.... When diseased, he should be registered and forced to make treatments before he offers his diseased mind and body on the altar of academic and professional education."

Anarcha was subjected to 30 experimental surgeries without anesthesia by Sims, the "father of gynecology"




Probably a more accurate representation of Sims' experimental subjects



#### **Grandison Harris:**

Slave, Porter, Judge, Teaching assistant and Resurrectionist

He was affiliated with Medical College of Georgia from 1852 to 1911



Slaves and Blacks were targets for autopsy and dissection.



#### Tuskegee Syphilis Experiment

1932-1972: 399 infected, 201 controls



Blood and spinal fluid were frequently drawn, providing a natural reservoir of syphilis bacteria for experimentation. The victims' bodies were sought after for autopsy.


## Exploitation of the Black Patients

Biopsy tissue taken from Henrietta Lacks' cervix in 1951 at Johns Hopkins Hospital was cultured and distributed by research pathologist, George Otto Gey, without her or her heirs' consent


Large profits were generated from HeLa cells derived from her cervical adenocarcinoma but no monetary distribution was ever made to the patient or her heirs

 Henrietta Lacks' heirs remained in poverty, mostly uninsured and suffered poor health

- The California Supreme Court (1990) held in *Moore v. Regents of the* University of California that individuals do not have an ownership interest in their cells after the cells are removed from their bodies
- "HeLa has helped build thousands of careers, not to mention more than 60,000 scientific studies, with nearly 10 more being published every day, revealing the secrets of everything from aging and cancer to mosquito mating and the cellular effects of working in sewers." # Medical Apartheid




Jim Crow (Neo-slavery): sharecropping Involuntary servitude, peonage "Injustice in healthcare is the most shocking and inhumane"

## Medical Apartheid

- **Segregation**: separate and unequal health facilities: private vs public hospitals. Jim Crow hospitals
- Health insurance: HMO vs PPO; Medicare vs Medicare Advantage; Medicaid vs private ins.
- Providers: black doctors in the south were denied access to medical societies and therefore hospital privileges until mid-1960s; clinic vs private office or faculty practice



# Moving from Scientific Racism and Medical Apartheid *Why should you care?*

- "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere" Martin Luther King
- •IOM 2013- US Heath in International Perspective: shorter lives and poorer health

Of 17 high-income countries studied by the National Institutes of Health in 2013, the "United States had the highest or near-highest prevalence of infant mortality, heart and lung disease, sexually transmitted infections, adolescent pregnancies, injuries, homicides, and disability. Together, such issues place the U.S. at the **bottom of the list for life expectancy**."

# Moving from Scientific Racism and Medical Apartheid

#### Equal rights and opportunity legislation? Affirmative action?

 IOM 2003- "The healthcare workforce and its ability to deliver quality care for racial and ethnic minorities can be improved substantially by increasing the proportion of underrepresented U.S. racial and ethnic minorities among health professionals"

Eliminate for-profit and some public-owned health facilities?

**Single payer health insurance?** IOM 2003- "payment systems should avoid fragmentation of health plans along socioeconomic lines."

Be aware of implicit bias and prejudice- racist ideas and institutions
